

# Status of civic amenities, dev work evaluated in Batote

## Directions given to prioritize patient care at CHC Batote

**RAMBAN:** Deputy Commissioner Ramban, Mohammad Alyas Khan on Tuesday conducted an extensive visit to Batote and reviewed the developmental scenario in the area, besides assessing the status of essential services and supplies.

The Deputy Commissioner took stock of essential services in the area including power and water supply, healthcare facilities, sanitation and road connectivity. He further reviewed the progress of ongoing developmental works and infrastructure projects.

As part of the visit, the Deputy Commissioner also conducted market checking in the town. He directed the enforcement departments to maintain strict vigilance against overpricing, hoarding and black marketing.

The DC also interacted with shopkeepers and members of civil society,

getting feedback on the availability and pricing of essential commodities and other civic issues. Emphasizing people-centric governance and public welfare, the Deputy Commissioner assured the public that their genuine concerns would be addressed on priority.

Later, the Deputy Commissioner visited the Langer site established for SANJY at Chanderkote and reviewed the maintenance for the smooth conduct of the pilgrimage.

Deputy Commissioner Ramban Mohammad Alyas Khan also conducted a surprise inspection of Community Health Centre (CHC) Batote to review the functioning of the healthcare facility and assess the quality of services being provided to the public.

SSP Arun Gupta; ADC Varunjeet Singh Charak; Addl. SP Mujeeb-ur-Rehman and other concerned officers accompanied the



Deputy Commissioner during the visit.

During the inspection, the DC inspected wards of the hospital and took stock of the facilities available for patients. He reviewed the availability of doctors, paramedical staff, medicines and diagnostic facilities.

He directed the health authorities to ensure adequate stock of essential medicines and proper maintenance of hospital infrastructure. Stressing the importance of patient care, he instructed the medical staff to remain responsive and ensure prompt and

compassionate service delivery.

The DC also checked the attendance and punctuality of the staff and directed that strict discipline be maintained. He emphasized that any negligence in duty would be dealt with firmly.

## DHJ takes stock of horticulture development initiatives in Marh

**JAMMU:** Director Horticulture Jammu (DHJ) Gul Syed on Tuesday conducted an extensive tour of Marh Block to review the progress of the horticulture development initiatives being implemented in the area.

He was accompanied by the Chief Horticulture Officer R.K. Kotwal and field functionaries of the department. The Director inspected the Revised Modified High Density Plantation (RMHDP) created by beneficiary Pooja Suri through an empanelled agency.
