Nepal Floods:
Toll surges to
1,200 mark

KATHMANDU: The death toll from Nepal's devastating flash floods crossed 1,200 on Wednesday, as rescuers battled rain and debris to trace those believed to be trapped in the tunnels along the course of the Bhotekoshi river and underground powerhouses.

Prime Minister Balendra Shah said the disaster's link to climate change must be strongly raised with the international community, as symbolic funerals were held by families of locals still missing after last week's flash floods.

According to Nepal's National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority, the death toll has reached 1,204 as more bodies were recovered from eight districts affected by the flood, while 4,216 people remain missing a week after ► P11

CB raids prime accused's
house in rape-death case

JAMMU: The Crime Branch on Wednesday raided the residence of the prime accused in the rape-and-death case of a 15-year-old tribal girl in Kishtwar, while authorities dismissed a second sanitation worker from the hospital in the case, officials said.

The case was handed over to the Crime Branch on August 29 following widespread condemnation and protests. A minor was raped allegedly by her school teacher over several months before she died during a pregnancy termination procedure on August 20.

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) of police has arrested a total of seven persons, including the main accused, his brother, two hospital sanitation workers and a nurse, in connection with an FIR registered at Chatroo police station under relevant provisions of the POCSO Act, BNS and the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

The officials said a Crime Branch team raided the residence of the prime accused along with the house of his brother.

Dr Karan Singh proposes
for Himalayan authority

NEW DELHI: Veteran Congress leader and former Union minister Karan Singh on Wednesday suggested the setting up of a Himalayan authority by Himalayan nations to help save the mountain range and urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take the initiative.

He also termed the four-laning of highways to connect the Char Dhams in Uttarakhand "reprehensible", saying the Government of India must adopt a proactive role in saving the Himalayas from destruction.

Singh also expressed deep sympathy with the people of Nepal over the loss of lives after the disaster, saying he has a special attachment with the country as his late wife hailed from the place.

"The cataclysmic events in Nepal have led to a considerable loss of life and property. I would like to express my deep sympathy with the people of Nepal in this hour of tragedy," Singh said, noting that his late wife was from Nepal, and thus, he has a special attachment with that "beautiful country" ► P11

India condemns destruction
of Hindu temple in Pakistan

NEW DELHI/ISLAM-ABAD: India on Wednesday unequivocally condemned the reported destruction of a Hindu temple in the Narowal region of Pakistan, demanding that Islamabad promptly investigate the incident and hold those responsible fully accountable.

New Delhi also said that Pakistan must take immediate remedial measures to restore the "desecrated temple" and fulfil its primary obligation to guarantee the safety, security and well-being of all its minority citizens and their cultural heritage.

"We have noted with deep concern the disturbing reports of the destruction of a historic Hindu temple in village Siraj, Narowal, Pakistan. We unequivocally condemn this reprehensible act of vandalism against a century old minority place of worship," External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said.

"The apparent apathy of authorities and failure to protect this century-old temple is alarming," he said.

Jaiswal said such incidents are a "stark reminder" of the continuing "vulnerability" of minority communities and the "egregious violations" of their religious freedoms and places of worship in Pakistan.

Jaiswal was responding to media queries on the incident.

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CM calls for biomass solutions
to decarbonize J-K's economy

SRINAGAR: Chief Minister Omar Abdullah today called upon engineers, scientists and academic institutions to harness Jammu and Kashmir's abundant biomass resources to develop locally suited, economically viable and environmentally sustainable solutions for reducing dependence on fossil fuels and decarbonizing the economy.

Corruption complaints
surpass 70K

NEW DELHI: More than 70,500 corruption complaints were received against government bodies last year, with banks and the Railways topping the chart, according to a report by the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC).

Out of the 70,584 complaints received by the chief vigilance officers (CVOs) – who act as the distant arm of the Commission – 64,905 were disposed of as on December 31, 2025, the report said.

"The remaining 5,679 complaints were under process at the end of 2025, including 2,002 for more than three months," the CVC annual report ► P11

RTI portal records over 65K
applications in 19 months

JAMMU: The online RTI portal for Jammu and Kashmir has received more than 65,000 RTI applications and 9,000 first appeals in 19 months since its launch, highlighting the increasing use of online mechanisms by citizens across the Union territory for accessing information, officials said.

The figures were disclosed by the General Administration Department (GAD) in response to an RTI application filed by Jammu-based RTI activist Raman Kumar Sharma.

According to the official reply issued on August 27, the J&K RTI online portal was officially launched on January 10, 2025, to facilitate citizens in filing Right to Information (RTI) applications online.

"According to the available records, the portal received 65,243 RTI applications between January 10, 2025, and August 26, 2026," the GAD said, adding that 9,033 first appeals were also received during the same period.

The J&K portal was launched by Chief Minister Omar Abdullah in 2025 whereas the Central online portal has been operational since 2013.

On queries about the number of public authorities, central public information officers (CPIOs) and first appellate authorities onboarded on the J&K portal, the GAD said the ► P11

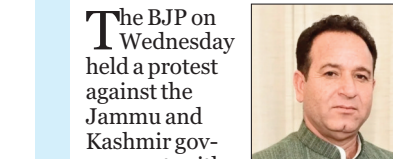

SRINAGAR/JAMMU: In the first major political protests after the abrogation of Article 370 in 2019, the ruling National Conference and the opposition BJP came out on the streets on Wednesday accusing each other of failing to deliver on promises made to the people of Jammu and Kashmir.

The NC accused the BJP-led Centre of not fulfilling its promise to restore Statehood to J-K, while the BJP alleged that the NC government failed to deliver on its electoral promises. Police stopped the NC protesters from marching towards the BJP headquarters in Jawahar Nagar to press for the restoration of Statehood after its ministers, MLAs, leaders and workers assembled in large numbers near the Gindun Sports Complex in Rajbagh. The party had proposed to 'gherao' the BJP office to protest against the Centre over the delay in restoring statehood ► P11
