

DM, SSP conduct security review of railway infrastructure; team inspects bridges, tunnels

REASI: District Magistrate (DM) Reasi, Vishesh Mahajan on Thursday conducted a comprehensive security review of critical railway infrastructure in Reasi district, including bridges, tunnels, and labour camps.

SSP Reasi Paramvir Singh, accompanied him during the inspection. The review spanned key sites from Reasi Railway Station to Sawalkote Railway Station on the readiness of security arrangements and welfare measures for workers.

Criminal detained under PSA

SAMBA: In order to curb the criminal activities in district Samba, Police has detained and lodged in jail notorious criminal under the Jammu & Kashmir Public Safety Act (PSA).

The accused identified as Alam Din alias Allu, son of Nazir Ahmed, resident of Manohar Gopala, tehsil and district Samba has involved in multiple criminal cases registered against him at Police Station Samba and Police Station Majalta of district Udhampur.

His criminal activities have posed a serious threat to public peace and tranquility.

Following his repeated engagement in criminal activities, detention order was issued by the District Magistrate Samba based on detailed dossiers prepared by SSP Samba. Police team of Police Post Rakh Amb Talli headed by Incharge PP Rakh Amb Talli under Police Station Samba successfully executed the warrant, leading to the incarceration of the said accused in District Jail Kathua.

Police nabbed 2 drug peddlers with heroin

SAMBA: Police has arrested two drug peddlers in the jurisdiction of Police Station Vijaypur and Police Station Samba and recovered approximately 08 grams of heroin like substance from their possession.

A Police Party of Police Station Vijaypur led by SHO Police Station Vijaypur during vehicle checking Naka near NHW Zamindara Dhaba, intercepted a motorcycle bearing registration No. JK02AQ-2427 for its checking. During checking, approximately 4.50 grams of heroin like substance has been recovered from the illegal possession of accused identified as Vishal Kumar S/o Som Nath R/o Bhour Camp, Satwari district Jammu. The said accused has been arrested and contraband item has also been seized.

DC Vishesh flags off vehicles to promote voter registration
