

MP thanks LG for raising Ladakh's Budget cut issue with Fin Min

Blames JTN for Budget underutilization, calls for unity and action

LEH: Hon'ble Member of Parliament from Ladakh, Mohamad Hanefa Jan has expressed gratitude to the Lieutenant Governor Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra (Retd.), for raising the issue of budget reductions in the Union Territory with Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman.



In response to the budgetary challenges, MP Jan convened a meeting with the Hon'ble Advisor to the LG and the Executive Council of the Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council (LAHDC) Kargil. Whereas, in response to the above notification, one official namely Sh. Mukhtar Ahmad, PET, filed an objection within the specified period, with the plea that in response to Advertisement No. 01 of 2013, dated 08.01.2013 (Item No. 12), and Advertisement No. 02 of 2015, dated 16.05.2015 (Item No. 02), the selection list of PETs was issued on 05.08.2015 and approached before the Hon'ble High Court vide SWP No 481/2018 dated 27.08.2018, and passed a direction (The writ petition is disposed off along with all connected IAs with the direction to the respondent to pass appropriate order in favour of the petitioner against the post of Physical education teacher retrospectively from the year the other similarly circumstanced candidates were selected/appointed viz 2015).

Whereas, vide Order No DYSSO-K/Estt-04/2018/1715-1717, dated 06.08.2018 District youth Services and Sports officer Kargil has issued a formal appointment order to the official in compliance to the direction of the Hon'ble High Court retrospectively from the same date when other similarly candidates were selected/appointed.

Whereas, this Directorate has examined the case and found Sh. Mukhtar Ahmad's claim to be genuine, as per Order of Hon'ble High Court.

Therefore, in view of the above, the second combined tentative seniority list of Coaches, Physical Training Instructors, Scout Organizers, and Physical Education Teachers, as per the seniority maintained by the District Youth Services & Sports Officers of Leh and Kargil, based on merit list issued by the concerned District Sub-ordinate Recruitment Boards is hereby notified in Annexure (A) for the information of all concerned. Objections, if any, may be filed within 10 days from the issuance of this notification.
